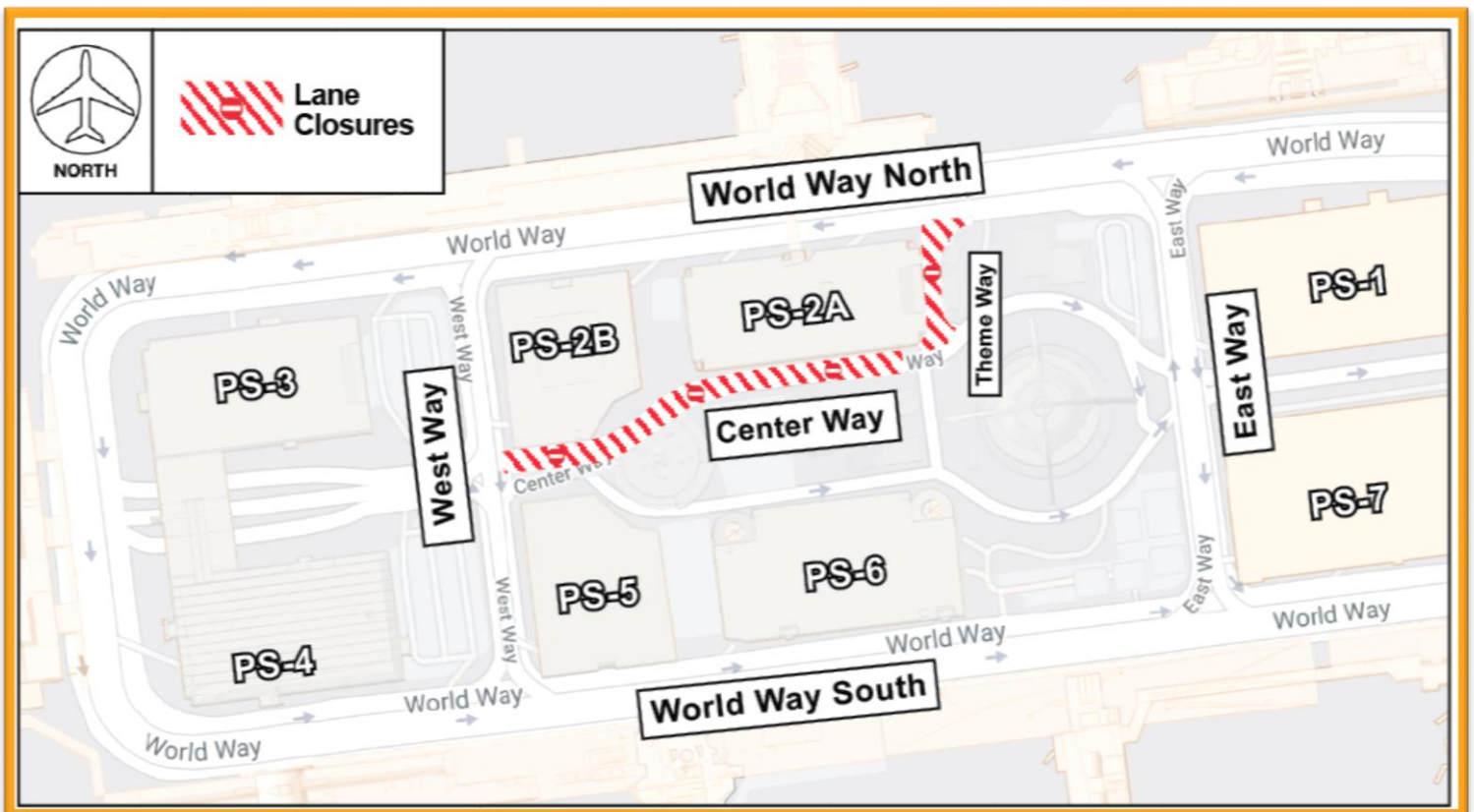

1. Center Way Restrictions

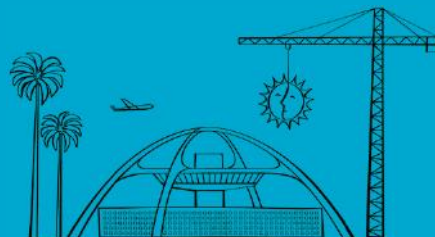
- The APM project will close Center Way from West Way to the egress of Parking Structure 2A continuously through November 20, 2020 for foundation work
- As a reminder Theme Way from World Way North to Center Way is closed through April 2022
- Flaggers are present and detour signage is posted to maintain traffic at all times, including egress of Parking Structures 2A, 5 and 6

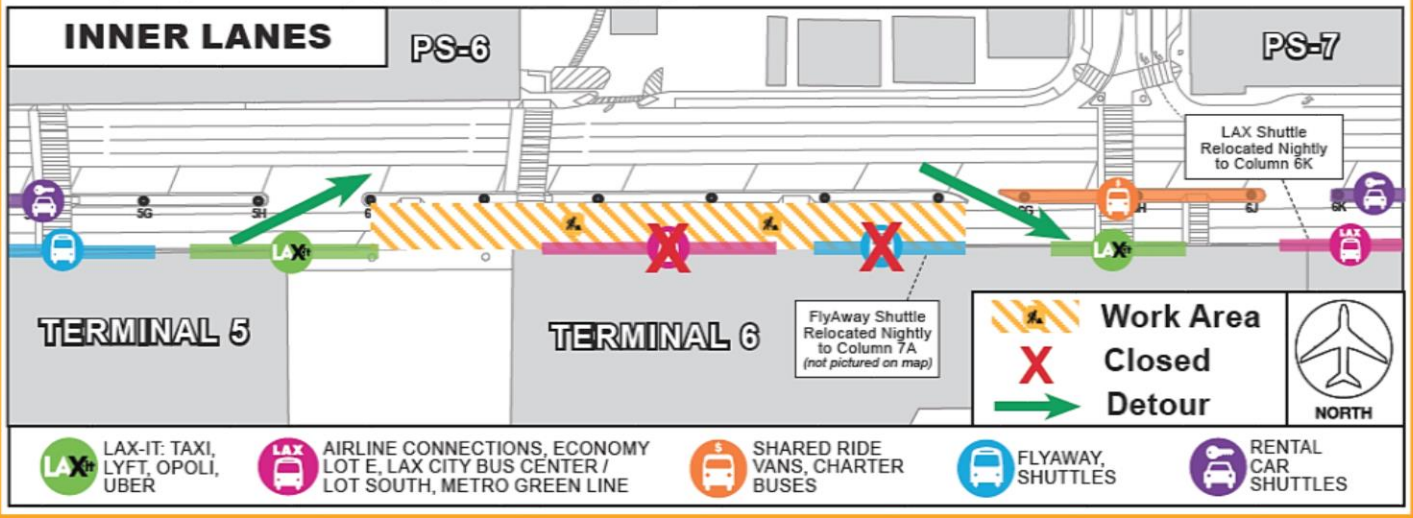
2. Terminal 5.5: Arrivals Level Lane Restrictions

- To perform utility work, the Terminal Cores & APM Interface project will restrict Arrivals Level inner lanes between Terminals 5 & 6 nightly (12am – 8am) this week
- Vehicular and pedestrian traffic will be maintained at all times
- Two inner lane shuttle stops will be impacted by this work; any closed stops will be relocated nearby with detour signage in place



INNER LANE CLOSURES:

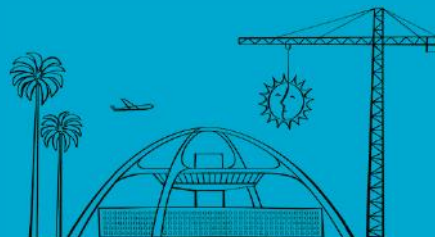
- Arrivals Level Inner Lanes and Shuttles between Columns 6A and 6F
- LAX Shuttle Stop (pink): Relocated nightly to Column 6K
- FlyAway Shuttle Stop (blue): Relocated nightly to Column 7A

3. Sepulveda Boulevard Tunnel Cleaning

- The Sepulveda Tunnel will experience nightly (11pm – 5am) lane restrictions this week for cleaning by the City of Los Angeles Bureau of Street Services
- Two lanes on either northbound or southbound Sepulveda Boulevard will be closed per night, with one lane maintained at all times
