1. Project Update: Airport Police Facility

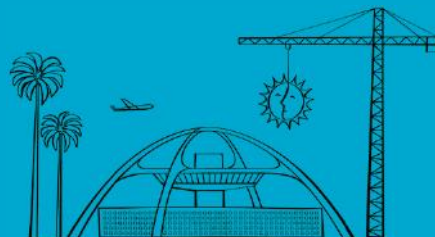
- Construction continues on the Airport Police Facility (APF) with the installation of finishing items such as furniture, flooring and other fixtures
- Outside, landscaping work continues as well as the construction of a 12-foot paseo along Westchester Parkway
- At the facility's adjacent parking structure, the build-out of interior spaces is ongoing
- The APF and parking structure are scheduled to open later this year

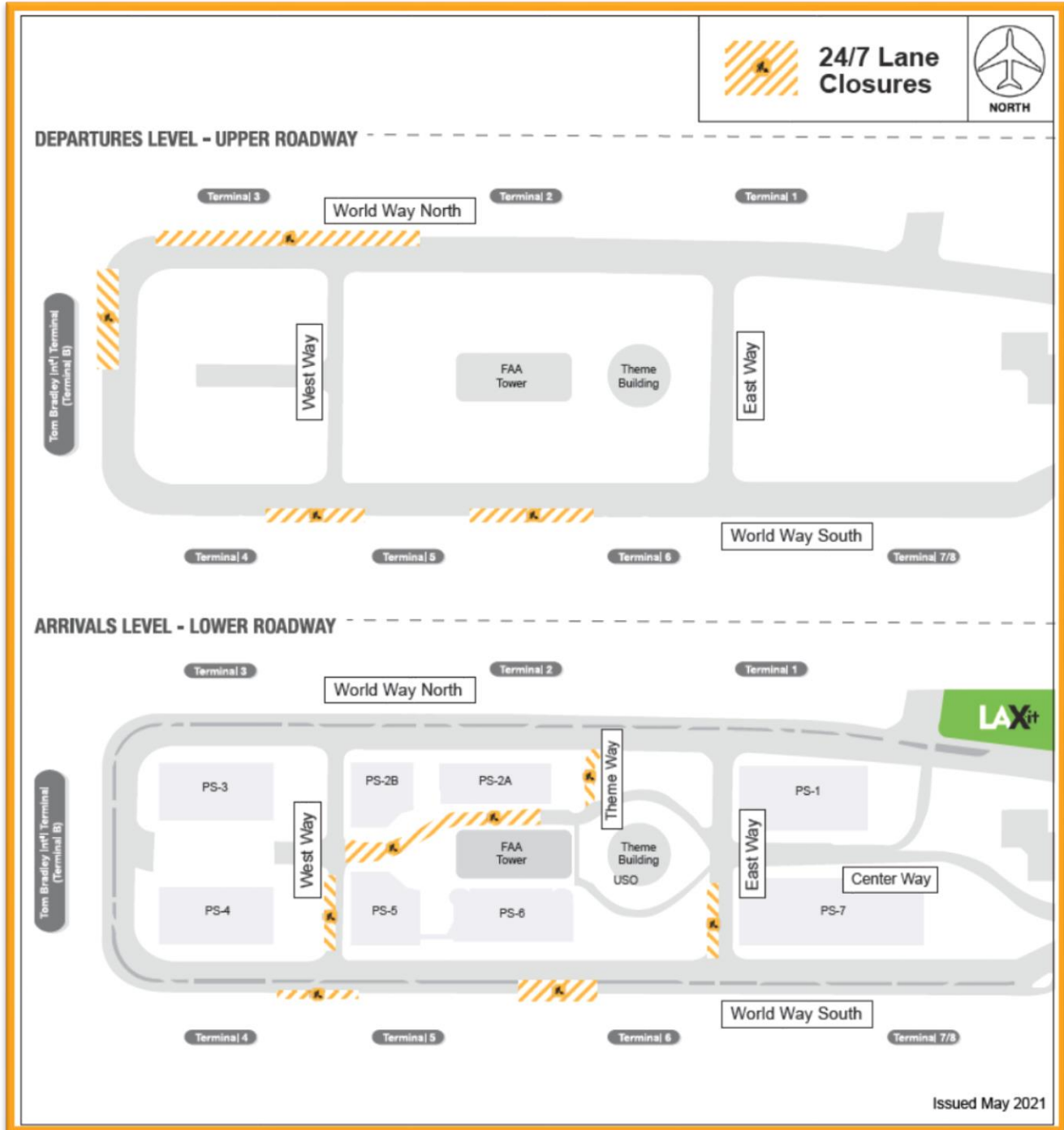

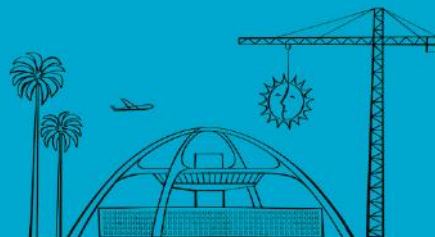
2. Upcoming CTA Lane Restrictions

3. Terminal 4.5: Construction Progress

- Construction is ongoing for the new vertical core between Terminals 4 and 5; photos below showcase progress over the last month
- Upon completion, the “Terminal 4.5 Core” building will connect with the Automated People Mover’s West CTA Station and also provide vertical transportation for Terminals 4 and 5
- With work occurring airside and landside, temporary pedestrian walkways are in place on both levels to direct vehicles and passengers around construction; traffic and passenger pick-up / drop-off is maintained at all times
