## 1. LAX CTA Holiday Construction Moratorium

- The LAX Christmas & New Year's Holiday Moratorium is currently in effect through Tuesday, January 3, 2023
- Construction activity will be limited during this time to alleviate potential impacts to guests during the busy travel season


## 2. City of Los Angeles Public Streets Holiday Construction Moratoriums

- In addition to LAX's CTA Holiday Construction Moratorium, the City of Los Angeles is implementing holiday season public street closure restrictions now through December 25, 2022

## 3. Thanksgiving Week Holiday Travel

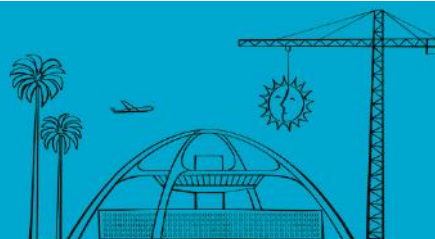
- With more than 200,000 passengers projected per day between December 16 and January 3, guests are encouraged to plan ahead to ensure a smooth airport experience
- Traffic around the Central Terminal Area is expected to surge with as many as 89,000 vehicles a day from between December 19 – 21, a 12% increase compared to the current daily average
- The aforementioned construction moratoriums have been implemented to lessen construction impacts to guests during this busier travel season impactful areas will be allowed
- LAX Parking Garages have seen historic use this year; guests are encouraged to pre-book a spot using [Parking.FlyLAX.com](https://Parking.FlyLAX.com), utilize the [LAX Economy Parking Facility](#) and free terminal shuttle, or use alternate options such as the [LAX FlyAway](#) service

- 1** Plan your parking ahead of time. The Central Terminal Area garages, and Economy Parking, are all likely to fill up quickly. Use [Parking.FlyLAX.com](https://Parking.FlyLAX.com) to book a space now. 
- 2** Use alternative transportation to access the terminals, including the LAX FlyAway bus, the Economy Parking free shuttle, or the Terminal B pickup area in Parking Structure 3. 
- 3** Arrive 2 hours prior to a domestic flight and 3 hours prior to an international flight. 
- 4** Use [LAXOrderNow.com](https://LAXOrderNow.com) to browse food and beverage options, and order online for easy pickup.

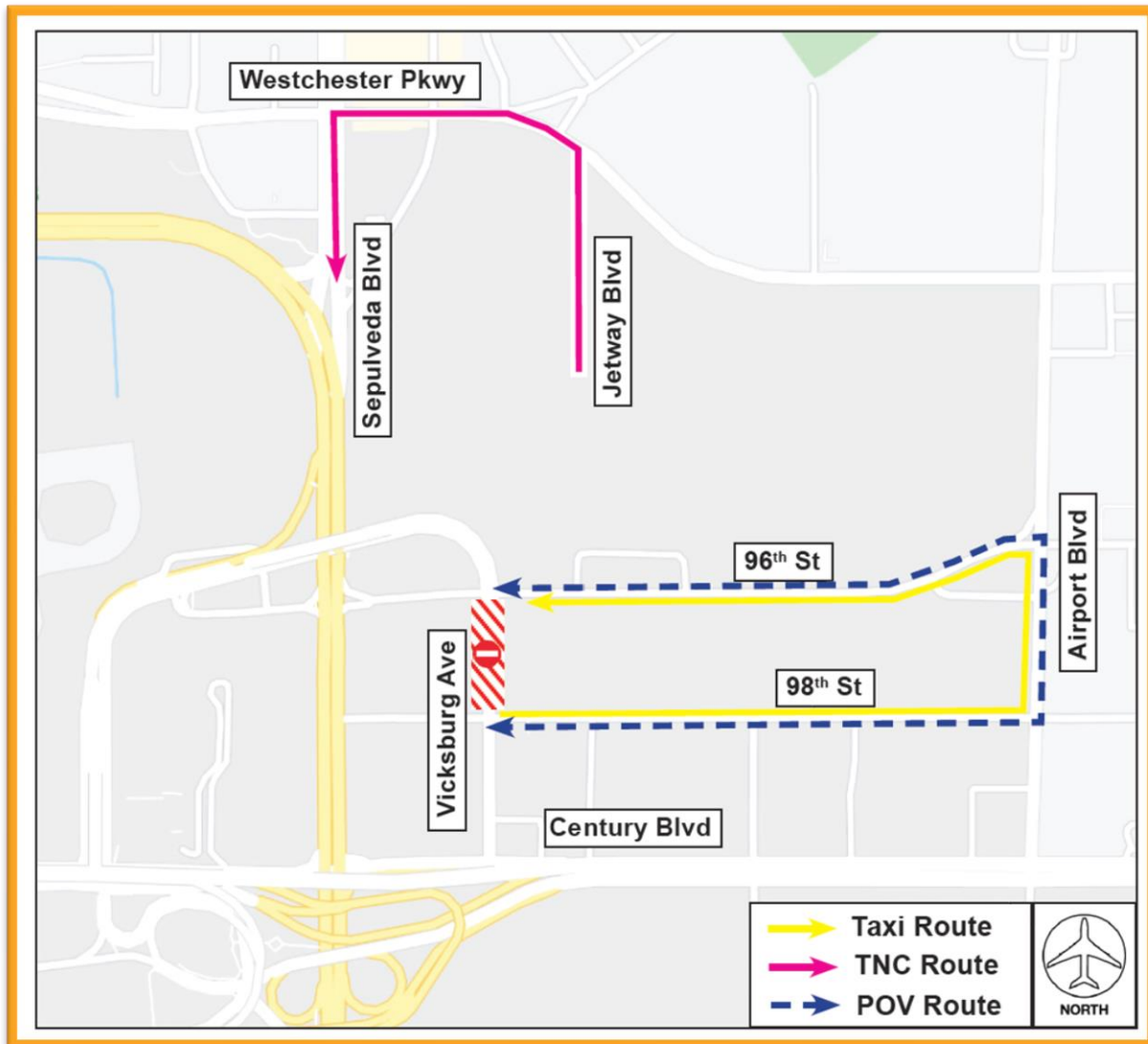

## 4. Vicksburg Avenue Closure: Impacts to POV, Taxi and TNC Routes

- To facilitate utility relocations for the Landside Access Modernization Program, Vicksburg Avenue between 96<sup>th</sup> & 98<sup>th</sup> Streets continues to undergo nightly closures through Saturday, January 28, 2023
- Closures start at 11PM with the roadway re-opened by 7AM
- Traffic will be maintained at all times via detours:
  - POVs maintained via Airport Blvd via 96<sup>th</sup> St or 98<sup>th</sup> St
  - Taxis maintained via 98<sup>th</sup> St to northbound Airport Blvd to westbound 96<sup>th</sup> St
  - TNCs maintained via northbound Jetway Blvd to westbound Westchester Pkwy to southbound Sepulveda Blvd



*Detours are in place to maintain traffic during nightly closures of Vicksburg Ave between 96<sup>th</sup> & 98<sup>th</sup> Streets*

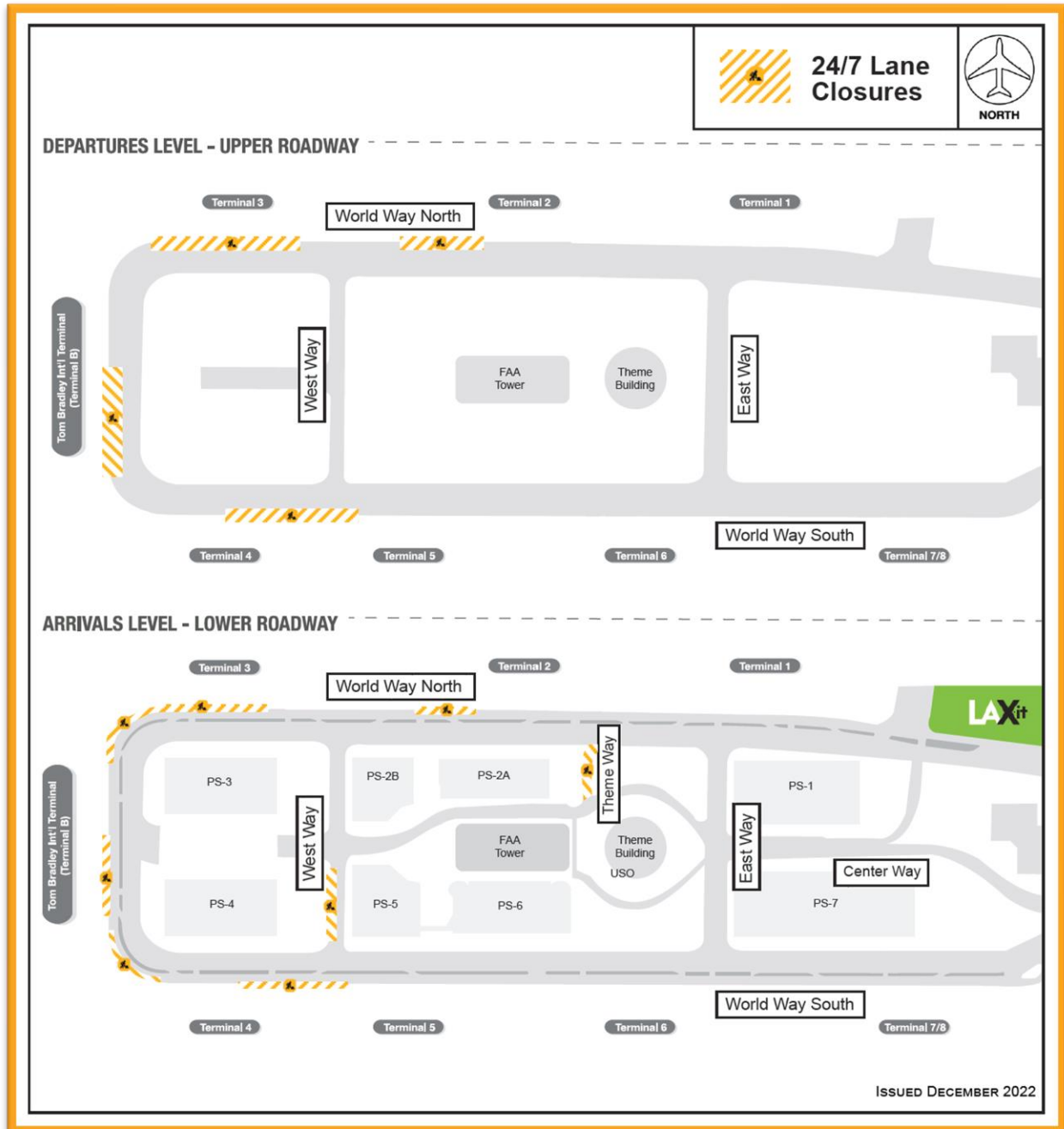
